# Resolution Authorizing the Purchase of Property at 16 Hillcrest Drive (SBL 156.-5-38.1), Ravena, NY For Use as a Town Hall

I,	Council member	offer the following resolution and mor	ve its adoption:
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WHEREAS, the Town of Coeymans and its government has steadily expanded over the past decades and as a result the Town Hall municipal office space currently being utilized at 18 Russell Avenue, Ravena, NY, is inadequate to serve the current and future needs of the Town, due in part to the age and condition of the building, inadequate space for all of the Town's offices, and lack of accessibility to public meeting areas and office locations.

WHEREAS, the Town requires adequate public facilities that meet the needs of current and future Town residents, including a Town Hall that is accessible to the public and staff, which is of great importance to the Town and its residents.

WHEREAS, the proposed use of the property located at 16 Hillcrest Drive, Ravena, NY (SBL 156.-5-38.1) (also known as "20 Hillcrest Drive") will allow the Town to centralize its main offices and expand departments, personnel and services, including the Town Supervisor's Office, Town Clerk's Office, Town Assessor, Town Building Department, Town Police Department, and Town Justice Court; with improved facilities that will benefit both Town and Village residents having business before the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town has explored a host of options to address the above, including, the construction or renovation of the current Town Hall at 18 Russell Avenue, Ravena, NY and/or the relocation of municipal offices to alternate sites; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration to costs related to all of the above, the Town Board has determined that the purchase of the real property at 16 Hillcrest Drive, Ravena, NY, which includes approximately 14,000 square feet of structures on approximately 4.8 acres of land, and which shall require certain capital improvement/renovation, shall allow for the relocation of one or more existing Town Hall municipal offices to a suitable location that provides adequate space and public access; and

WHEREAS, Town Law § 220(2) authorizes the Town to purchase lands and buildings for a town hall and other municipal purposes and provides that such acquisition is not subject to

permissive referendum if the purchase is made from monies appropriated from surplus funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board duly noticed and held a public hearing on September 14, 2023 to consider the input of the community on the proposed acquisition of the land and buildings at 20 Hillcrest Drive, Ravena, NY for use as a Town Hall; and

WHEREAS, the proposed action, the purchase of real property located at 16 Hillcrest Drive, Ravena, NY for use as a town hall and other municipal purposes, is a Type II action under 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(18) ("SEQRA") involving "[r]euse of a residential or commercial structure, or of a structure containing mixed residential and commercial uses" where the use is permitted by applicable zoning laws and does not meet or exceeds any of the thresholds in SEQRA Part 617.4"; and

WHEREAS, the town has prepared a proposed contract for the purchase of the property in the amount of \$425,000.00 and the Town Board has reviewed the same; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has duly reviewed and considered all other relevant planning, zoning and environmental factors and makes the following findings:

- 1. The action is for the purchase of real property located at 20 Hillcrest Drive, Ravena, NY for use as a Town Hall and other municipal purposes; and
- 2. The property is presently improved with a  $\pm$ 14,000 sq ft (former) church building and small outbuilding on  $\pm$ 4.8 acres; and
- 4. The use of the property for Town Hall purposes is a principal use in the R-2 zoning district of the Village of Ravena, which includes community buildings; and
- 5. The parking on site is adequate for the needs of Town Hall; and
- 6. The reuse of the existing facilities and improvements on site will result in no significant adverse environmental impacts and will provide the residents of the Town of Coeymans with a centrally located modern and functional Town Hall facility; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Town Board of the Town of Coeymans hereby classifies the purchase of real property located at 16 Hillcrest Drive, Ravena, NY for use as a Town Hall, as a Type II action pursuant to SEQRA; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, the Town Board authorizes the purchase of improved real property located at 16 Hillcrest Drive (SBL 156.-5-38.1), Ravena, NY for \$425,000.00 for use as a Town Hall and other municipal purposes; and

**RESOLVED**, that property shall be purchased with surplus funds to be transferred and withdrawn from the town's Capital Projects "H Fund" account; and

**RESOLVED**, the Supervisor is authorized to enter into and execute contracts of sale and other closing documents to effectuate the purchase.
