Call to Order

Site Plan Review

Keystone Novelties Distribution LTD (Crown Point LTD): A site plan application for a 4th of July tent sale (Keystone) located at 2369 US 9W, Ravena, NY Tax Map #168.5-1-14.12 (Crown Point)

Keystone was not ready to attend the meeting; Mr. Cashin will check with them to attend the March meeting. This will need a public hearing and a 239 to be submitted to Albany County. Mr. Cashin reported that the Police Chief said there were no issues/incidents last year.

Preliminary Sketch Plan

Palange: Mr. Hite was inquiring as to the possibility of a two lot subdivision.

Mr. Palange wants to keep 100 ft. frontage on Cedar Grove Road, scaling it down because he doesn't want to lose any more property. In the event they want to develop beyond the road, they will have footage for connector road. Mr. Foronda asked the board members if they have a problem with the flag lot as long as it is 60 feet – no one had any objection .

Miscellaneous

Updates: Lawson Lake Road Campground - nothing new. Dog Kennel on Miller Road – nothing yet.

There is a huge solar farm planned on Route 101 (Mark Flach's property). The idea of using sheep to keep grass under control is being considered.
