1. Review January 7 Planning Board Meeting

- a. Carver Company Lawyer Biscone sought site review for new construction intended to be leased for Yanni's Too restaurant.
 - i. Mark Yanni is currently leasing a building very near the proposed construction site at 16 Marina Dr, Ravena, NY 12143.
 - ii. The review included retaining two current building, constructing an new facility and expanding parking to accommodate 150 vehicles.
 - iii. MM noted SEQR and other review processes are likely

2. Supervisor Philip Crandall shared updates on proposed local Clean Air Law.

- a. Crandall reiterated that Clean Air law will not be noted on on 10 January.
 - Lafarge had a permit to burn tires, but it expired in May 2018. There had previously been a question on whether the incineration law would

- conflict with the permit and make the Town subject to potential litigation.
- ii. On advice of town lawyer, Coeymans will send the proposed law to Albany County Planning Board for review
- iii. The Town will also conduct a SEQR review of law implications.
 - 1. There is a concern of increased dioxin levels in the air if Lafarge burn tires in the interest of power production and waste tire management.
- b. In summary, by covering all the bases, we have done due diligence to make an article 78 or similar challenge by Lafarge or other opposing parties groundless.

3. NRI Updates

- a. SL Laura DeGautano and Sylvia will look over edits. Karin a Verschoor is interested in editing the geology related materials.
- b. Per SL, We expect to publish the NRI by the Spring.

4. Other business

- a. Per DB the Town would like to combine electronic recycling with the event. Dan will contact board officials for more background on the process.
 - We want to promote positive visibility during a more general conservation mindset.
- b. SL met with RCS Community Library Director, Judith Wines, recently library to partner to create a naturalist club at the high school.
